Tema Central	Conceptos para Estudiar
<b>Would</b>	We use <i>would</i> for requests, offers, invitations and wishes.  Example: -Would you like some coffee? Yes, I would. -I would like to go to Europe.
<b>Present continuous</b>	We use this tense to mention that an action is happening right now. Also, it is used for future arrangements.
<b>Regular and Irregular verbs.</b>	-The <i>regular verbs</i> end in 'ed' in past and past participle. -The <i>irregular verbs</i> often change in past and past participle.
<b>Present perfect</b>	This tense is used to express actions that occurred in an indefinite time before the present. Also, it is important and it continues in the present.
<b>Present perfect (since/for)</b>	We use <i>since</i> : to indicate the specific moment when something started.  We use <i>for</i> : to indicate the period of time of something.
	Example: -I have brought my lunch. -She has driven a car.  Have: I, you, we and they. Has: He, she and it.  There are some examples to use <i>since</i> and <i>for</i> : <i>Since</i> : Last Christmas, February, 2015, I was a child and Monday. <i>For</i> : many years, 6 months, a long time, ten minutes and 3 weeks.
